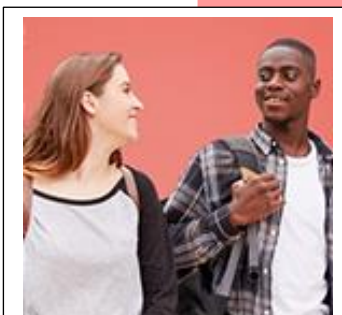

First aid skills (Inc. CPR, Drs ABC, using the defib) and responding in an emergency.

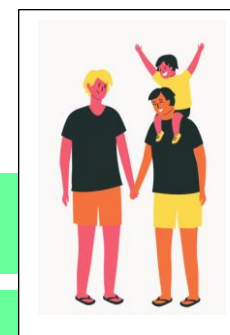
Lifestyle choices and impact on mental health and emotional wellbeing (Inc. sleep).
