

## Timeline of Houses

Up until summer 1990, we had four boys' houses with mixed day and residential students: China, Gravesend, Khartoum and Woolwich.

### 1990

- In autumn 1990, Augusta House opens for day and residential girls.

### 1992

- In autumn 1992, Buckingham House opens as a boys' day house.
- Windsor House opens as a girls' boarding house.
- China, Gravesend and Woolwich are re-named and no longer exist.
- Sandringham and Balmoral open as boys' boarding houses.
- We now have five houses in total: Augusta, Windsor, Sandringham, Balmoral and Buckingham.

### 1994

- In autumn 1994, Buckingham House splits into two and becomes Buckingham Junior and Buckingham Senior.
- The Annex opens for seven full-boarding sixth form boys and Windsor House now has day girls as well as boarders.

### 1998

- In autumn 1998, Kensington House opens for day girls.
- Buckingham merges back into one house.
- Khartoum and Gravesend open as boys' day houses.

### 2003

- In autumn 2003, China House opens as a girls' day house.

### 2009

- At the end of the summer term 2009, the Annex closes.

### 2016

- In autumn 2016, Victoria House opens for day girls.

### 2019

- In autumn 2019, Woolwich House opens for Y7 residential boys and girls.
