### Key Words / Skills:

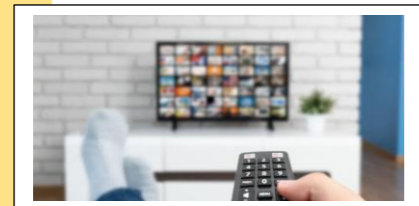
Students will practise 4 skills of LISTENING, READING, SPEAKING AND WRITING:

Y7 – using present tense accurately, talking about yourself and others, giving simple opinions.  
(KS3 grade 1-3)

Y8 – using the present and perfect tense, talking about the world around you, giving opinions and justifications.  
(KS Grade 2-4)

Y9 – using present, perfect and future tenses across a range of topics, giving more complex opinions and justifications.  
(KS Grade 3-5+)

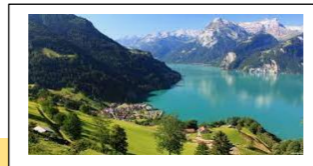
**2.3 Bleib gesund!**  
talk about typical breakfasts and German foods, understanding and using recipes, talking about healthy lifestyles, using irregular verbs and the imperative



**2.2 Bist du ein Medienfan?**  
talking about film and TV preferences, talking about reading habits, discussing screen time, asking questions, using modal verbs, using prepositions with the dative case

**2.4 Klassenreisen machen Spaß!**  
understanding rules, discussing daily routine, understanding and giving directions, describing a festival, using reflexive and separable verbs, using adjectives to describe nouns  
KA2: U4 Kontrolle (KS3 Grade 2-4)

**2.5 Wir gehen aus!**  
discussing clothes and style, going on a date, getting ready to go out, talking about how the date went, using "wenn" clauses, using the past tense

**2.1 ich liebe Ferien!**  
comparing places "then" and "now", talking about what you did on holiday, talking about the weather, using the perfect tense with "haben" and "sein"

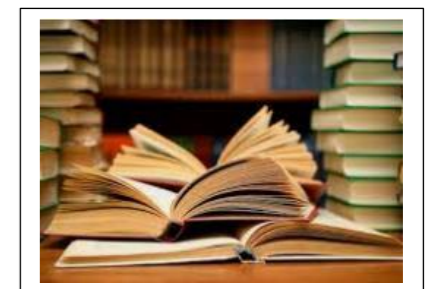
**1.1 Meine Welt und ich**  
Introducing yourself, counting to 20, saying where you live, spelling words, describing your character, asking and answering questions about belongings

**1.2 Familie und Tiere**  
talking about pets, using "kann + infinitive", talking about family members and ages, describing family members, talking about birthdays, using ordinal numbers  
KA1: U2 Kontrolle (KS Grade 1-2)

**1.3 Freizeit – juhu!**  
talking about sports and leisure activities, using "gern" with verbs, giving your opinion, using adverbs of frequency and correct word order, talking about mobiles and computers, using the present tense



**1.4 Schule ist klasse!**  
talking about school subjects, using "weil" to give reasons, talking about days and times, describing your teachers, using "sein" and "ihr", talking about school facilities and rules, using prepositions

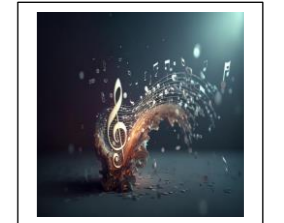


**1.5 Gute Reise!**  
saying what there is/isn't in a town, using "es gibt + ein/kein", using "ich möchte" to say what you would like, buying snacks and drinks, using Euros, talking about holiday plans

**3.1 Vorbilder**  
learning parts of the body, talking about role models, overcoming injuries and misfortune, revising present and past tenses

**3.2 Musik**  
talking about types of music, using "sein" in the present tense, discussing bands and making comparisons, describing a music festival, using separable verbs in the perfect tense  
KA1: U2 Kontrolle (GCSE Grade 2-5)



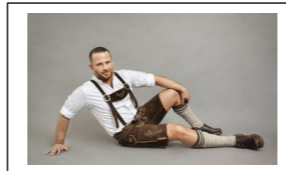
**3.3 Meine Ambitionen**  
discussing ambitions and job plans, talking about what you like to be or do, talking about working in a ski resort, using "um...zu" clauses, using correct word order

**3.4 Die Kindheit**  
talking about your childhood, comparing primary and secondary school, talking about fairy tales, using the imperfect tense, using "als" for when in the past

**3.5 Rechte und Pflichten**  
talking about age limits, discussing what is important to us, using "weil" correctly, comparing life in the past, present and future, understanding and using all three tenses
