Major General Andrew Sturrock MA MEng MSc MInstRE

Major General Andrew Sturrock was commissioned into the Corps of Royal Engineers in 1996 after reading Manufacturing Engineering at Cambridge University. He Commanded 5 Field Squadron and 39 Engineer Regiment, serving on operations and exercises in Kenya, Northern Ireland, Bosnia-Herzegovina, and Iraq, and contributed to both the 2010 and 2015 Strategic Defence and Security Reviews. He later led Army Infrastructure Plans before moving to United Kingdom Strategic Command as ACOS Infrastructure, overseeing infrastructure delivery across the United Kingdom and Overseas estate.

Since July 2023 he has been the Defence Infrastructure Organisation's Director of Strategy and Plans, leading work on strategy, planning, digital, asset management and sustainability.

A keen sportsman, he shoots for Scotland and the British Army, enjoys skiing and Munro bagging, and is married to Jayne, with three school age children. He was elected President of the Institution of Royal Engineers in January 2026.

THE PRIZES

Almost all the prizes awarded will be in the form of books. Each book contains a bookplate giving the basis for the award and is signed by the Chair of The Gordon Foundation.

Prizes awarded this morning fall into one of three broad categories: Form prizes, subject and specialism prizes, and character development or leadership awards. The Form prizes are awarded for effort and attitude.

Subject prizes are awarded for academic excellence in a particular subject area. The development and leadership awards take into account the development of strengths and character of a student or recognise a level of leadership shown during the course of the year.

The Gordon Medal

is now awarded to the School Sergeant Major and Colour Sergeant every year. In addition, the Medal is awarded to the Pipe Major and Drum Major in recognition of services to the Pipes and Drums, and to each House Captain in recognition of services to marching and parades.

The Higginson Medal

is awarded to the Head Boy and Head Girl each year.

The Elizabeth Award

is the school's highest accolade, not necessarily awarded every year. It is awarded to students for one-off exceptional acts of selflessness or to those who have consistently bled green and put the school and others ahead of themselves on too many countless occasions to measure.

Such students epitomise 'Better Me, Better World' and are the role-models for the Gordon's person we wish all students to be.
