ASSESSMENT:

The suitable candidates will be invited to an assessment day.

This will involve:

- Skill and technical knowledge demonstration in their chosen art form
- Interview with either the Head Teacher or a Deputy Head, the Director of Creative Arts and an Arts Lead during which they will be expected to talk convincingly about their commitment and enthusiasm to the Creative Arts



HOW TO APPLY:

Candidates should:

- Complete an application form and attach a letter summarising their Creative Arts activities and achievements over the last two years (no more than one side of A4 written by the student).
- In support of their CV, there should be a creative arts specialist reference and a behaviour/character reference (these may be from a present coach/ teacher from the last two years).
- Submit video footage of a solo piping performance.
