BOK SMART RULES

Rugby Fixtures

In 2015, the South Africa Rugby Union introduced new regulations to protect players under the age of 18. These rules stipulate that no player may appear for a team if he is over age or if he is more than two years younger than the maximum stipulated age for that particular age group.

In practise, the players must fall into the below age brackets stipulated below.

Bok Smart Rules

Under 13 Teams (U13) = Players aged 11, 12, or 13

The younger players, who are aged 11, must have turned 12 by the 31st December to be eligible to play in this age category. The older players, who are 13, must still be 13 by the 31st December to play in this age category. Those players aged 12 may play in this category throughout the year whether they are 12 years old or 13 years old by 31st December.

Under 14 (U14) = Players aged 12, 13, or 14

The younger players, who are aged 12, must have turned 13 by the 31st December to be eligible to play in this age category. The older players, who are 14, must still be 14 by the 31st December to play in this age category. Those players aged 13 may play in this category throughout the year whether they are 13 years old or 14 years old by 31st December.

Under 15 (U15) = Players aged 13, 14, or 15

The younger players, who are aged 13, must have turned 14 by the 31st December to be eligible to play in this age category. The older players, who are 15, must still be 15 by the 31st December to play in this age category. Those players aged 14 may play in this category throughout the year whether they are 14 years old or 15 years old by 31st December.

Under 16 (U16) = Players aged 14, 15, or 16

The younger players, who are aged 14, must have turned 15 by the 31st December to be eligible to play in this age category. The older players, who are 16, must still be 16 by the 31st December to play in this age category. Those players aged 15 may play in this category



throughout the year whether they are 15 years old or 16 years old by 31st December.

Under 17 (U17) = Players aged 15, 16, or 17

The younger players, who are aged 15, must have turned 16 by the 31st December to be eligible to play in this age category. The older players, who are 17, must still be 17 by the 31st December to play in this age category. Those players aged 16 may play in this category throughout the year whether they are 16 years old or 17 years old.

Under 18 (U18) = Players aged 16, 17, or 18

The younger players, who are aged 16, must have turned 17 by the 31st December to be eligible to play in this age category. The older players, who are 18, must still be 18 by the 31st December to play in this age category. Those players aged 17 may play in this category throughout the year whether they are 17 years old or 18 years old.

Under 19 (U19) = Players aged 16, 17, 18, or 19

The younger players, who are aged 16, must have turned 17 by the 31st December to be eligible to play in this age category. The older players, who are 19, must still be 19 by the 31st December to play in this age category. Those players aged 17 or 18 may play in this category throughout the year whether they are 17, 18 or 19 years old.
