The ILM Level 2 Award for Aspiring Student Leaders is ideal for individuals who are actively engaged in leadership or hope to be in the future. The aim of the award is to develop the knowledge and skills needed for improving leadership within their school community.

Key elements of the Programme:

Students will undertake two taught units of work which each carry an independent written assignment task:

- Developing Self-Leadership and Resilience for Young People.
- Developing Leadership Skills for Young People.

Format:

The course will involve workshops, presentations and group discussions. Students will be supported during the course by an assigned course tutor.

Course Outcomes:

- *Learn essential skills in leadership and self-management*
- *Develop an understanding of the role of mentoring*
- *Build evidence of new skills through a portfolio*
- *Improve personal accountability and motivation*
- *Achieving a nationally recognised qualification*
