

Lil Lambley is an executive producer and theatre leader with deep expertise in commercial theatre, fundraising and financial governance. She has led organisations through periods of structural change, high growth and market disruption, including the successful relaunch and scaling of Anthology Theatre Productions right in the midst of Covid-19.

At Anthology, Lil delivered productions and services for leading UK and international partners, whilst also producing home-grown titles including BLEAK EXPECTATIONS in the West End starring Stephen Fry, Dermot O'Leary and Lee Mack amongst others.



Lil has worked at senior level with leading organisations including Sonia Friedman Productions, Ambassador Theatre Group, the Royal Shakespeare Company. She has also overseen productions in the West End, on tour, in Saudi Arabia and in New York.

Lil is a board member for Society of London Theatre and is a Stage One mentor and recently completed maximum term on the board of trustees for Headlong Theatre. Alongside all that she is a busy mum of two active boys, one of whom is enjoying his first year at Gordon's.
