DID YOU KNOW?

Every job in the Army offers the opportunity to progress to gain professional skills leading to higher qualifications, including full Bachelors and Masters Degrees. Technical Corps like the Royal Engineers or the Royal Electrical and Mechanical Engineers, will support you in gaining civilian qualifications. such as gaining Chartered Engineer status.

WHAT HAPPENS AS A REGULAR SOLDIER?

98% of soldiers enrol on an apprenticeship, making the Army one of the largest apprenticeship programmes in the UK. The courses are designed with other employers, ensuring the training is to industry standards and approved by the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education.

WHAT HAPPENS AS A REGULAR OFFICER?

You can start your Army officer career at the age of 18 - you don't need a degree, just good A Levels or equivalents. You can gain a degree while serving as an officer and, if you're still in education, you might be interested in our scholarship and bursaries.
