Why is work experience so valuable?

Choosing a career is not something anyone else can do for you so give yourself the best chance at the future you want by making the most of work experience opportunities.

- Stand out from the crowd in a competitive market
- Develop new skills and learn what transferable skills you already possess
- Test the waters: discover what the job or industry is really like before committing to a career path
- Demonstrate to employers that you are motivated to learn and gain your own experience
- Make contacts and develop your network

But how do I get work experience?

- Decide what job or industry you'd like to try and research the companies you'd like to work for. Do they offer work experience schemes? Can you travel?
- Prepare your CV or contact letter, tailored to each placement or company you are contacting. Include any relevant experience, including school achievements and clubs, why you are passionate about the industry, and soft skills.
- Research who to contact within a company. Look online or call the office administrator. Don't miss a deadline. Make sure you have applied on time if there is a closing date. Plan to contact at least 10 companies.
- Ask for help from family and friends. Do you already know someone in the industry?
- Be proactive. Follow up on the letters you've sent with a call or email it shows initiative.
- Be interview ready. You may be invited to speak with or meet a company representative ahead of being offered a position. Consider what questions they may ask. Dress professionally.

Do your research, aim high and don't be afraid to ask!
