COURSE DETAILS

Examination

The course is examined as a whole at end of Y13 (A level).

Paper 1: Listening, reading and writing (Y13).

Listening and Reading Comprehension questions on Aspects of Germanspeaking society and Artistic culture, Aspects of political life and Multiculturalism in the German-speaking world. There are also written summaries to complete from aural and written sources (90 words)

Grammar - German to English translation (90 words)

Written exam: 2hours 30 (A level) (50%)

Paper 2: Writing (Y13).

Written essays (ca. 250 words) on **one set text** and **one set film** from the approved lists in the specification. Film: **Lola Rennt: Tom Tykwer** Play: **Andorra: Max Frisch. Grammar – English to German translations** Written exam: **2 hours (A level) (20%)**

Paper 3: Speaking (Y13)

Discussion of stimulus card based on one sub-theme i.e. Aspects of Society and Artistic culture, Aspects of political life and Multiculturalism plus discussion of Individual Research Project on a topic of your choice Speaking exam: 21-23 minutes (A level) (30%)
