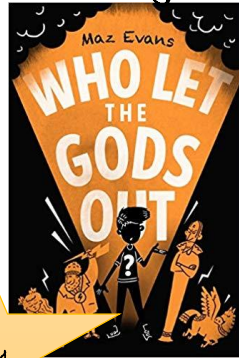


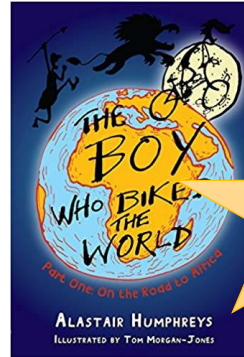
# Year 7 Recommended Reading

The first book in a series by a National Geographic Adventurer of the Year. Written in short chapters and diary entries, this is an accessible read about a boy who wants to cycle around the world.

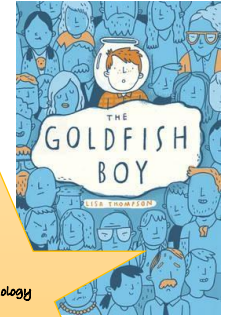
Politics

Matthew suffers from OCD and struggles with day-to-day. He watches the world from his window – that is until his neighbour goes missing and Matthew is determined to solve the mystery.

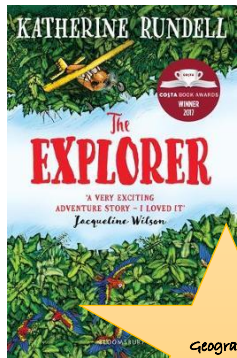
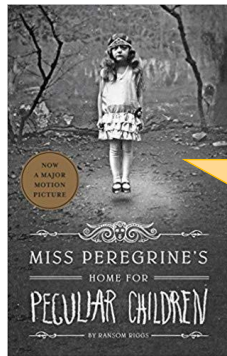


Drama

Follow Louie's story as she works to become a circus tightrope performer. A showstopping read.

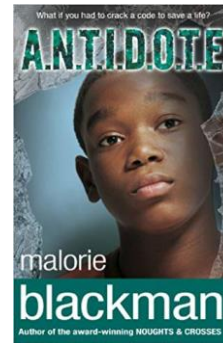
**Miss Peregrine's Home For Peculiar Children**
