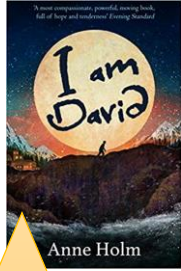

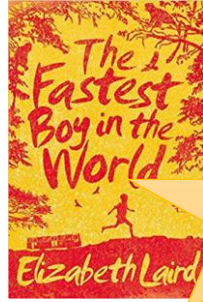

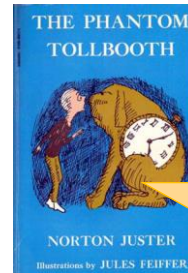
Art

Drama

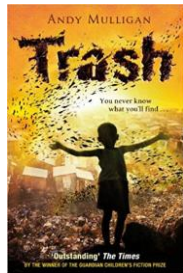
The Diamond of Drury Lane

Maths

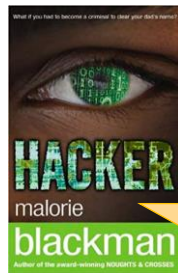
Hacker

A fantasy adventure where Milo is transported to a world full over chaos and disagreement over whether letters and numbers are equally important.

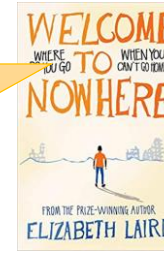

Omar and his older brother find themselves fleeing to safety during the unrest in Syria.



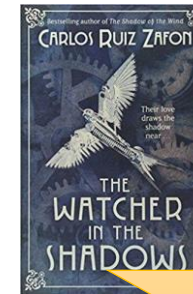
Psychology
