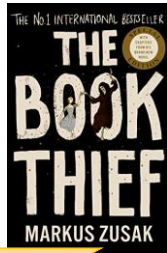

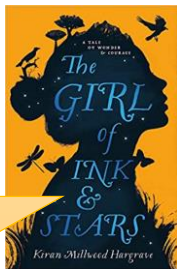
If you like these subjects, then try reading...

### The Understudy

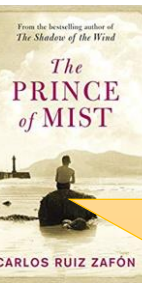
Full of comedy, romance, and an actor hoping for his big break, David Nicholl's novel is a light, but brilliant read.

A touching tale that follows Christopher as he tries to solve the murder of his neighbour's dog.



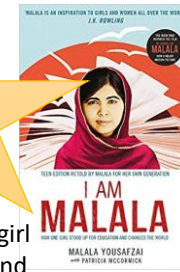

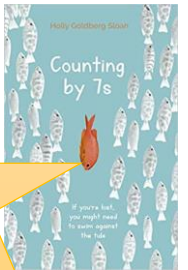


### I Am Malala
